Background IU FSPH



- Started as a Department in the IU School of Medicine based on the IUPUI campus
- Became the IU Richard M Fairbanks School of Public Health in September 2012
- Received Council on Education for Public Health accreditation for the school in June 2015
- Offers 10 degrees programs in public health and health administration



Background-HPM PhD

- Required 1 credit seminar usually in 3rd year
- Speakers-journal entry
- “Job talk” with (peer review)
- Abstract or article submission
- ePortfolio with (peer review)

Background

I am a doctoral student in health policy and management at the Indiana University Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health at IUPUI. I started my degree work after several years in public health with the intent to acquire new knowledge, skills, and abilities (competencies) and to refine and strengthen competencies I have acquired through my career in public health. This site is designed to present information regarding the competencies I have gained through my work as a doctoral student and as a public health professional. The competencies required for my doctoral degree are described in the panel below.

In addition to the knowledge, skills, and abilities I have worked on in my doctoral program, during my career I have had the opportunity to develop and apply skills in leadership, management, planning, strategic planning, program design and implementation, program evaluation, quality improvement, policy development and implementation, and organizational development. I also had the opportunity to work with public and private organizations to develop supportive strategies for shared projects or to develop resolution of differences in strategies. These included federal agencies, state agencies, professional health associations, voluntary health associations, and academia.

All positions required the ability to prepare and make public presentations on agency or program activities to a variety of public and private organizations. These included Federal agencies, state agencies, the Indiana General Assembly, professional health associations, voluntary health associations, community groups, academics, etc.




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
Competencies/Projects Example



Examples of ePortfolios

- Addressing Autism in Old Order Amish Children in Northeast Indiana (2015)
- This report presents information on cultural and health practices of Old Order Amish that may influence the accessing of services to address cases of autism spectrum disorder among Old Order Amish children. The report provides a high level proposal to developing an intervention that addresses cultural aspects of the Old Order Amish that may improve the likelihood of accessing services outside the Old Order Amish communities.

Student Example of ePortfolio

 - B) I have taken coursework in the area of Public Health Ethics (PBHL-H 670) where I developed a final project and demonstrated my understanding of the principles and theories of bioethical principles.
- 3) Design and conduct health policy and services research studies.
 - C) In my current position I work as a health information project coordinator. In that role I am able to have some limited role in the methodology that is used

- I liked WIX and actually bought a domain name, but I found Tumblr as a microblog site was easier for sharing and posting, my original materials-or blogs published on another site
- I believe ePortfolio is helpful for job searching and brings extra value to impress potential employers. Learning how to develop ePortfolios is very helpful for graduate students. I would recommend it for other students.
