CHANGE

- A catalyst is needed for Self-Directed Learning
- Interest in learning arises from a personal need or curiosity of the person
- A catalyst stimulates the process of SDL

Covid-19 became a catalyst.

LEARNING APPROACHES

- Collaborative Learning

- Self and peer assessment
- Student centered instead of teacher centered
- Self-Efficacy
- Need to engage with others
